## **The Process Approach**

Inputs – Meeting with Front Line Staff

A process is a series or set of sequential activities that interact to produce a result; it may occur once-only or be recurrent or periodic.

**Initial Draft Process** Map designed Must represent WAD Consensus – Final Draft Process Map designed Training -Implementation Compliance - Noncompliance Review and Improvement (CI)

WAD – Work As Done

A procedure is a document that instructs workers on executing one or more activities of a business process. It describes the sequence of steps, and specifies for each step what needs to be done, often including when the procedure should be executed and by whom.

A degree of inspection is required to ensure that key tasks and the process outputs meet set standards.
